The 2012 OPWA Fall Technical Workshop will give attendees an opportunity to gain practical experience from the challenges faced on recent high profile and sensitive projects. Case studies will feature municipal Public Works projects covering several themes.

The lessons learned and the solutions derived will be shared with all. A number of viewpoints will be showcased, as presenters will include municipal representatives, consultants, and industry associations.

The workshop consists of the following topics:

- **Interchange Design in York Region** – *A review of environmental issues during construction, in-field changes to manage construction issues, and lessons learned.*
- **Implementing a Diversion Program in Multi-Residential Buildings** – *See how the unique challenges related to communication, accessibility, contamination and safety at Multi-residential buildings affect the implementation and tracking of your multi-res diversion program.*
- **Replacement of the Burgoyne Bridge** – *A heritage bridge over 12 Mile Creek that no longer functions adequately must deal with issues that include: archeological and heritage values, aesthetics and endangered species.*
- **Managing Construction Soil** – *What are we doing about excess construction soils in Ontario? RCCAO will speak to best management practices and a new industry-led initiative called Supporting Ontario Investments in Lands (SOIL).*

- **Public Outreach for the St. Clair Project** – *An overview of the public outreach process, results and future considerations for other similar projects.*
- **Municipal Roundabouts** – *Planning your roundabouts includes solid communication with residents in addition to proper design.*

Please take this opportunity to learn from the practical experience that will help make your own municipal projects more successful. This will be an informative and worthwhile day.

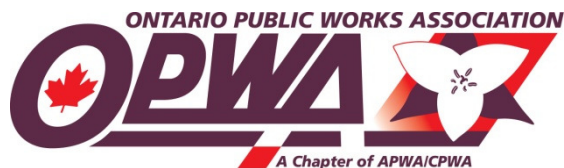
